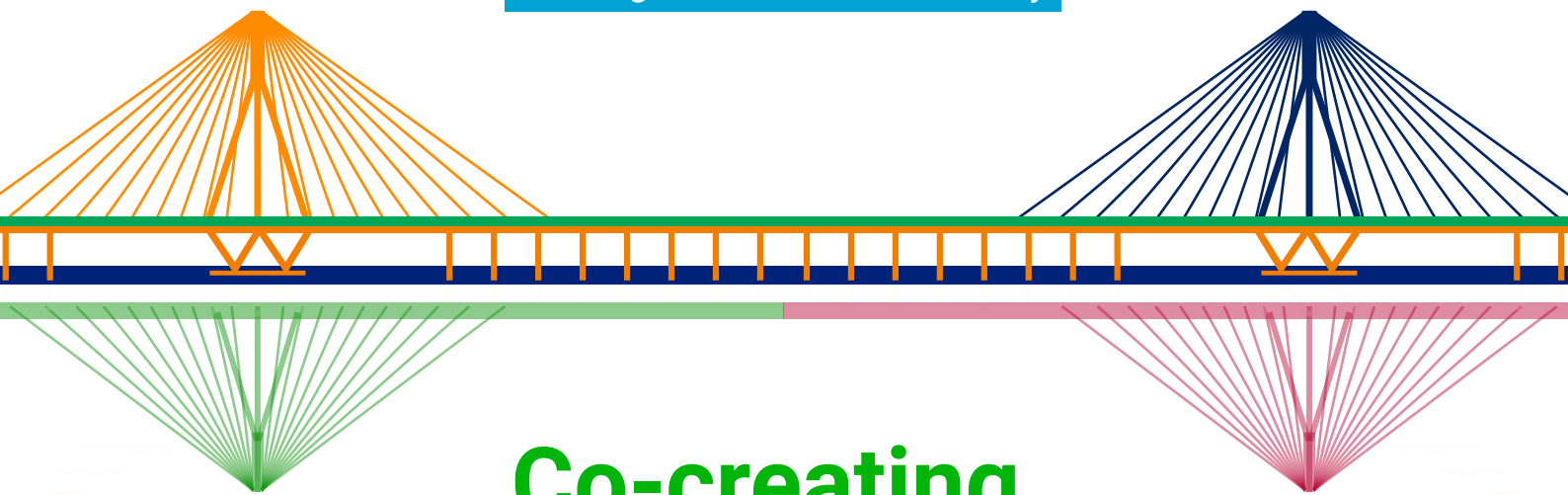

THE REASON



We have reached a point in history where we are in grave danger of destroying Earth's life-sustaining capacity.



But our attempts to protect natural ecosystems are increasingly ineffective because our very conception of the problem is limited; we treat "The Environment" as its separate realm.



The world's cities occupy just 3 percent of the Earth's land but account for 60-80 percent of energy consumption and 75 percent of carbon emissions.



Half of humanity – 3.5 billion people – lives in cities today, and 5 billion people are projected to live in cities by 2030.



Ninety-five percent of urban expansion will occur in the developing world in the following decades.



Eight hundred twenty-eight million people live in slums today, primarily found in Eastern and South-Eastern Asia.



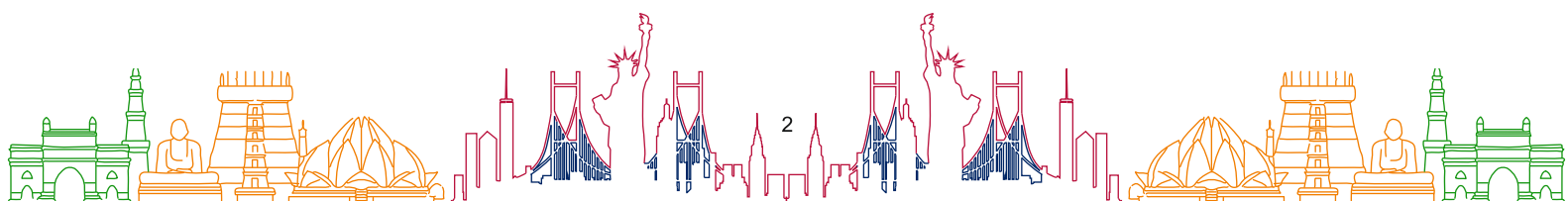
Rapid urbanization is exerting pressure on freshwater supplies, sewage, the living environment, and public health.



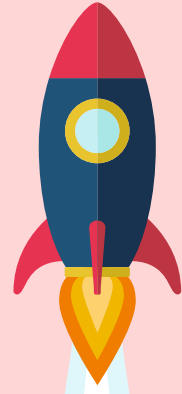
Cities account for 60 and 80 percent of energy consumption and generate as much as 70 percent of human-induced greenhouse gas emissions.

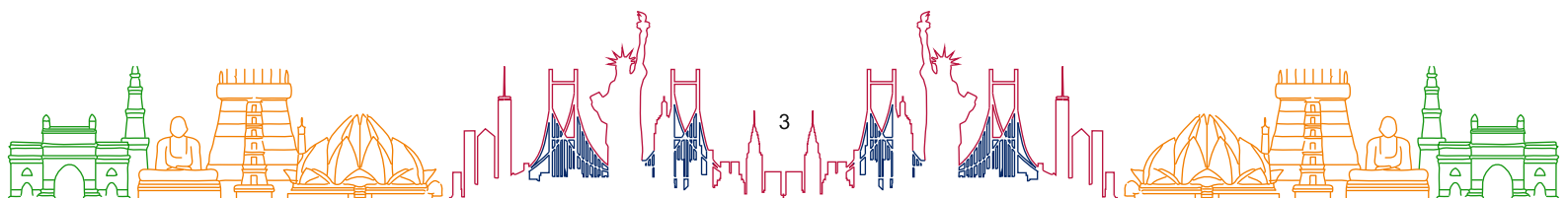

PURPOSE

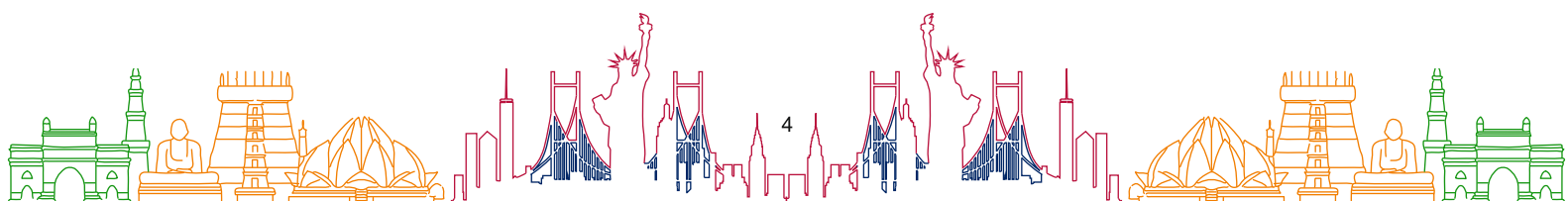

Green City Governance Auditing and Certification is a Set of Global Sustainability indicators containing governance, citizen services, mobility, sanitation services, safety, energy sourcing, Air Quality, Water quality, health & resource utilization, and Built-up Spaces.

Each Green City Governance Auditing & Certification Indicator is measured against Global Standards for Green City Governance Auditing and Certification Process.

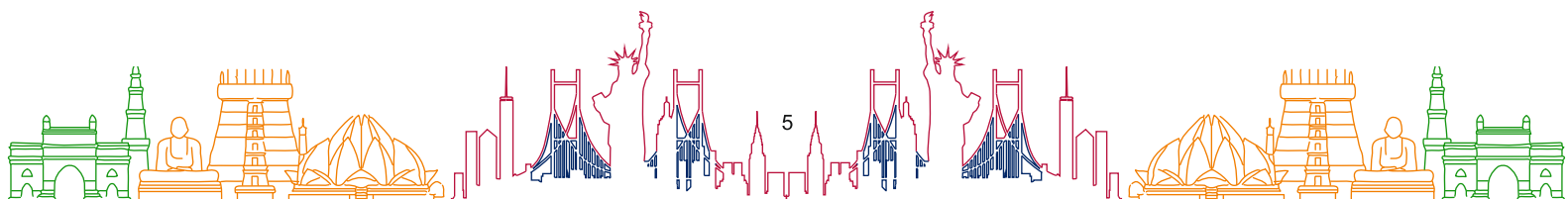

Advocacy

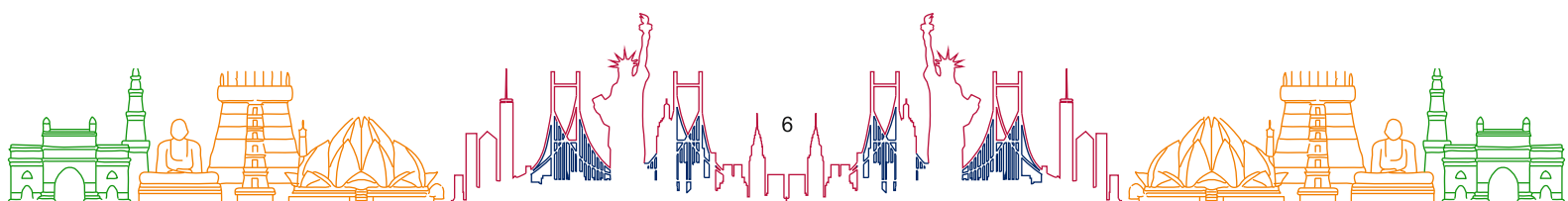

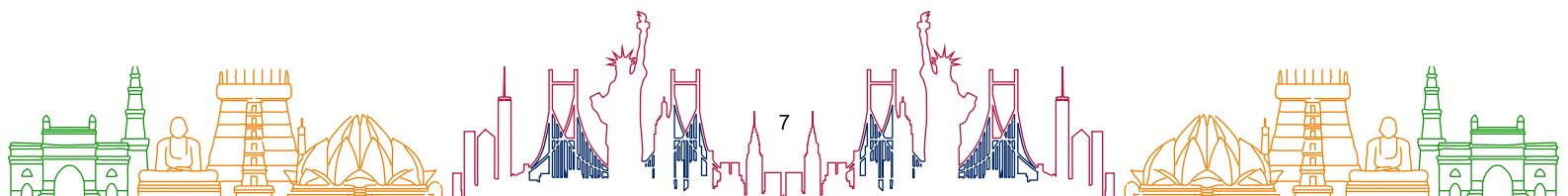
Building camaraderie and bonding with your colleagues helps you learn how to be a better leader and will help build lasting friendships.
